Dr. S. Bruce Archibald is a paleobiologist currently working as a Research Associate at Simon Fraser University, The Royal BC Museum in Victoria and the

Museum of Comparative Zoology Harvard University. He earned a Bsc in biology at Simon Fraser University and a PhD in Evolutionary Biology at Harvard University. His dissertation was on understanding the relationship between biodiversity and climate by including a paleontological perspective. He returned to Simon Fraser in 2007 working on BC's fossil insect communities and what they tell us about the processes underlying the structures of modern communities and their historical development.
