### GENERAL COMMENTS

No wheeled vehicle access into reserve was noted. General area of Reserve still advertised by Forests ministry as recreation area with signs and parking lot provided for the purpose.

The radio tower on McBride Peak had fallen and was apparently non-functional. The tower near the northwest boundary was the only one still looking like a functioning communications installation.

General state of reserve appeared good with the only sign of human use being a well defined footpath along the summit ridge of McBride Peak and another well defined footpath following the south boundary of the reserve and heading for Teare Mountain.

No reserve boundary sign were in evidence. Sign replacement mentioned in 2006 report has not been done.
