Please share the contents of this note and the attachments with Kris Kennett.

Following up from our joint visit to this ecological reserve on July 28, I attach sketch maps showing the proposed boundary between a park portion and an ecological reserve portion for this area.

During our visit we confirmed that the distinct boundary visible in the field and on air photographs between the closed forest and the more open vegetation on the bluffs is also the logical boundary for the proposed division of this protected area into a park and ecological reserve portion. There are no rare or particularily sensitive species on the forest side of the boundary.

Ideally, there should be a forested buffer included in the ecological reserve portion. However, due to the small size and narrow shape of the total area under BC Parks control, we may not have the "luxury" of including a buffer.

I suggest to draw the dividing line as shown in yellow on the air photo (dotted on the boundary map).

I am also enclosing an updated check list of plants which includes only species found in the proposed ecological reserve portion. (By comparison with the old list it is obvious that the vast majority of plant species occurs on the more open habitats and that including the closed forest portion would not add many species.)

Please ensure that a copy of the species list finds its way to the volunteer wardens, once appointed.

I hope that creating a park portion will enable the district to exert a degree of control over the use of mountain- and trail bikes in this area.


