Field Survey - Alpha Islet, Griffin Island and Jemmy Jones Island

Alpha Islet:

Three rare species were surveyed - *Sanicula arctopoides* (52 plants over 52 m²),
Ranunculus californicus (350+ plants over entire island [1.79 ac.] and *Castilleja levisecta*
(2870 plants over several hundred m²)

Griffin Island

One rare species - *Ranunculus californicus* (5000+ plants over entire island)

Jemmy Jones Island

No rare species

All of these rare species sites are Aranks except the *Sanicula* which is probably Brank.
