

BC Parks Regional Park Enhancement Fund Community Partner Application Form

Each year BC Parks makes \$240,000 available from the Park Enhancement Fund (PEF) to support community-led conservation and recreation projects in parks across the province. Please read the details below to learn more about the application process, eligibility requirements and criteria.

Application Process:

- 1. All applications are due by May 25th, 2021 please submit to your local BC Parks contact with a copy to BCParks.Volunteers@gov.bc.ca.
- 2. Applications will be reviewed by BC Parks and applicants will be notified by June 30, 2021.
- 3. Approved projects will require applicants to sign a funding approval letter prior to commencing the project.
- 4. Approved projects will be required to submit a short final report by March 31, 2022.

Eligibility Requirements

- Funding requests must not exceed \$5000 per project.
- o Project must be completed by March 31, 2022.
- Project must be led by volunteers or community partners.
- o Applicants must have discussed the project with BC Parks staff prior to applying for funding.
- o Project must not be in contravention of a valid park management plan.
- Projects must fit within one of the following categories:
 - Conservation research, invasive species removal, monitoring, restoration
 - o **Recreation** trail and facility enhancements, interpretation or education, diversity & inclusion, community engagement and events, and visitor experience projects.

Who can apply?

- Indigenous Partners and Communities
- BC Parks volunteers
- Academic researchers
- Non-profit organizations
- Park Operators

Applications will be reviewed based on the following criteria:

- 1. Alignment with BC Parks priorities;
- 2. Benefit(s) to the park;
- 3. Engagement with other community or volunteer partners;
- 4. How the funds will be leverage through other contributions (cash or in-kind);
- 5. Realistic and achievable project activities and timelines.
